"The Whitney"-Combination Containers
Eligible for Grower's Choice Award - Containers not to exceed 24" in diameter/length

- Class 1. Any combination in a container
- Class 2. Dish gardens
- Class 3. Terrariums
- Class 4. Troughs

SECTION B

"The Schuylerville"-SGC Container Grown Lettuce
Challenge Award
Eligible for Schuylerville Garden Club

- Classes 5, 6, & 7 need a 3" X 5" card telling how there plant was grown.
- Class 5. Lactuca sativa "Baby Oakleaf" - 1 head. Container not to exceed 8" in diameter.
- Class 6. Lactuca sativa "Claremont" - 1 head. Container not to exceed 8" in diameter.
- Class 7. Lactuca sativa "Cherokee" - 1 head. Container not to exceed 8" in diameter.
- Class 8. A combination planter using 3 or more heads of lettuce (any variety). Container not to exceed 15" in diameter.
- Class 9. An ornamental combination planter using at least one head of lettuce (any variety) and other decorative plants. Container not to exceed 15" in diameter.
