DIV II **DESIGN** **“It’s All in the Game”**

SECTION A **“Fun and Games”** Designer’s Choice Award

Class 1 **“Building Blocks”**

A **Construction Design** to be staged on a 12” high platform with a 18” x 36” rectangular **top** staged on a dark gray rug. Optional underlay. Designer’s Choice of materials.

HB p.74 **_A Creative Design** with strong architectural characteristics using geometric form or forms combined in to a single 3D unit. Construction limited to 1 or 2 types of material. Must include plant material.

Class 2 **“Monopoly”**

A **Featured Plant Material Design** to be staged on a white 35” pedestal with an 18” top, to be viewed from all sides. Optional underlay/drape

HB p.74 A design with an emphasis on 1 plant species (not genus) may include subordinate components but focus is on chosen species.

Class 3 **“Chutes and Ladders”**

A **Line-Mass Design** to be staged on a table space 36” wide x 30” deep covered in white, in front of a tan wall. Staging panel optional.

HB p. 71 & p.74 A **Design** where line is dominant e.g. straight, curved, freeform, having additional components to support the line.

SECTION B **“Winner Takes All”** Tri Color Award

Class 4 **“Tug of War”**

A **Creative Design** in two units of unequal size having a prominent component connecting the 2 units, to be staged on a table space 36” wide x 30” deep covered in white, in front of a tan wall. Staging panel optional.

Class 5 **“Twister”**

A **Cascade Design** to be staged on a 35” gray pedestal with an 18” diameter circular top, to be viewed from the front. Optional underlay/drape. Height of design unlimited.

HB p.73 A design with an emphasis on a downward rhythmic movement. Downward lines may be curved, straight, zig-zag, interrupted or may be a combination. Design is supported by a container or device. A minimum of components may extend upward.

Class 6 **“Old Maid”**

A **Functional Table** for 2, to be staged on a card table with a top no larger than 36” x 36” square, in front of an olive-green curtain. To be judged from the front although sides visible.

SECTION C

“It’s How You Play The Game”

Petite Award

Class 7

“Connect Four”

A design not to exceed 8” in height, width or depth, using at least 4 out of 6 components supplied by the committee in addition to plant material of designer’s choice, staged on a raised area draped in black. Staging panel optional.

Class 8

“Left, Right and Center”

A Parallel design, not to exceed 8” in height, width or depth, to be staged on a raised area draped in black. Staging panel optional. Designer’s choice of plant material.

HB p.75 A design consisting of 3 or more groupings of plant material and optional components with a strong parallel placement in a single container and/or base.

Class 9

“ Marbles”

A **Design**, not to exceed 8” in height, width or depth, incorporating a ball/balls, to be staged on a raised area draped in black. Staging panel optional, designer’s choice of plant material.
